

**ADMISSION TERMS FOR FOREIGNERS (UKRAINIAN CIVILIANS,
WHO RUNNING AWAY FROM THE ARMED CONFLICT IN THE UKRAINE, HAVE
ARRIVED IN LATVIA AFTER FEBRUARY 24, 2022)
Latvian Academy of Sport Education
academic year 2022/2023**

Due to the tragic events in Ukraine, caused by the brutal military invasion by the Russian Federation and the destructive war against a sovereign country and its inhabitants and the necessity to give support to Ukrainian civilians, who want to study in full time studies at LASE, LASE states the following admission terms and the documents to be submitted:

1. The status of Ukrainian civilians is the **one of EU citizens**.

1.2. Requirements upon commencing the study programme:

- Age: 18 years old or older. If a Ukrainian civilian is younger than 18 years, he/she has to have a legal person in Latvia, who is responsible for him/her;
- Secondary education (applying for undergraduate study programmes) or bachelor education (applying for master study programmes), or master education (applying for doctoral study programme);
- Corresponding knowledge of Latvian or English: the document issued in last 5 years attesting the English language skill on at least B2 level should be submitted. If no certificate, English examination should be taken;
- Written entrance examination – Social Examination (applying for undergraduate study programmes);
- On-line video interview.

1.3. Foreigners can apply for study by coming in person, electronically (sending the documents electronically, when coming to LASE, original documents should be shown) or by mail; the following **documents** should be submitted:

- 1) application;
- 2) diploma of education copy and copies of grade transcripts;
- 3) health certificate (in free format general opinion of a doctor that the applicant is healthy and can study for a professional sports programme that includes physical load, confirmed with a stamp and signature; the text must be legible and written in English or Latvian (in Latvia form 027/u), valid for one year);
- 4) 2 photograps 3x4 cm*;
- 5) copy of passport;
- 6) copy of visa to stay in Latvia;
- 7) copy of a certificate confirming knowledge of Latvian or English**;
- 8) registration fee payment notice (25.00 EUR, the remaining amount of 125 EUR is covered by LASE finances);
- 9) safety deposit (500.00 EUR) **should not be paid**;

Notes: * *photographs should not be sent electronically*;

** *the mentioned document should not be attached if:*

- a) *the secondary education is obtained in English*;
- b) *in a foreigner's, who has acquired secondary education in a EU/EEZ country, document confirming the secondary education there is comparison of his/her English language knowledge, confirming at least B2 level of CEFR system*;

1.4.1. Ukrainian civilians have the right according to the contest to claim a budget places.

1.4.2. If the budget place is not given, the tuition fee is the same as for Latvian students (the difference is covered by LASE from its finances):

- The 1st level professional higher education programme “EDUCATION AND SPORT SPECIALIST” (cods 41813) – 1500.00 EUR for one academic year;
- Professional bachelor higher education programme „SPORT SCIENCE” (code 42813) – 1790.00 EUR for one academic year;
- Professional master higher education programme „SPORT SCIENCE” (code 47813) – 2076.00 EUR for one academic year;
- Professional master higher education programme „VESELĪBAS APRŪPES SPECIĀLISTS SPORTĀ” (code 47722) – 2060.00 EUR for one academic year;
- academic doctor higher education programme „SPORT SCIENCE” (code 51813) – for one academic year.

2. Documents can be submitted (for September intake): till 31.07.2022.

3. Ukrainian civilians, who have not arrived in Latvia, can apply for LASE study programmes following LASE Admission Terms for Foreigners.
